COLOR GUARD

The Villages Christmas Parade (December 2, 2022)

The Band of Brothers (BoB) Veterans Group will be led by the (BoB) Color Guard and banner. The staging area located off Del Mar / Avenida de las Casas behind the former Rialto Theatre. (map attached)

The staging area opens at 11:30am (1130) **HOWEVER**, all interested participants should arrive no later than 2:00pm (1400) to allow for set-up and staging. All groups must be staged and ready to go at 2:30pm (1430). The total number of participants and carts must be provided to the Marshall at 2:30pm (1430). The parade starts promptly at 3:00pm (1500).

The Band of Brothers has been assigned **slot** #18. Golf carts wishing to participate in the parade must have a placard displayed. We have been given six passes in addition to "the tank". Placards will have these available at both Lake Sumter and Brownwood City Fire locations next week.

As a reminder, no political signage can be displayed on golf carts and there is no throwing of candy, etc. They ask that any marchers NOT wear a Santa costume, but hats, elf ears, reindeer antlers, etc. are permitted.

Lady Lake Christmas Parade (December 3, 2022)

The Band of Brothers (BoB) Veterans Group will be led by the BoB Color Guard and banner. All interested parties





should arrive no later than 9:30am (0930) to allow for set-up and staging. The parade starts promptly at 10:00am (1000).

The Band of Brothers has been assigned slot #7.

It is best to enter the staging route onto West Hermosa Street. The staging area will be from US Hwy 27 / 441. Access will be denied down Guava Street from US Hwy 27 / 441.

The parade does NOT start and end at the same location! The parade proceeds south down 1st Street, then east down CR 466, then south down Old Dixie Highway until Griffin View Drive. Parade ends at Griffin View Drive. (Total distance = 0.80mi)

Please arrange to either walk back to the staging area or have a vehicle to drive back up to the kick-off location. A map is attached showing the staging area access and the parade route.
