#### FROM THE DESK OF YOUR PRESIDENT

I am pleased to announce that former Vice President-South, Jack Orr has accepted our invitation to serve as Public Affairs Director (PAD) with responsibilities outlined in our Bylaws. Thank you, Jack, for your continued service and contributions to the Band of Brothers.

As you are aware from recent newsletters and conversations at our socials, we will be revising our Bylaws to be subject to, and governed by, the Non-Profit Corporation Act of Florida. As our organization is growing, we need to assure its continuity, and governance for the generations to come. We are currently evaluating required verbal changes to follow the state of Florida as well as operational changes which will make our processes smooth, coherent, and reasonable to follow.

Our current bylaws restrict voting to those members who are REGULAR Members. Regular Members are described as those who must be miliary veterans who were either retired or honorably discharged from active duty, Reserves or National Guard <u>and</u> who must have a permanent/full-time residency within a 50-mile radius of The Villages. This is what the bylaws say, and this is how we must proceed with any vote to revise or change the bylaws.

The template for new bylaws will refer to all voting members as members of the Board of Directors. It reads as follows — "The Organization shall be governed by a Board of Directors (the "Board"), which shall have all the rights, powers, privileges, and limitations of liability of directors of a non-profit corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Act of Florida. The Board shall establish policies and directives governing business and programs of the Organization and shall delegate to the Executive Board, subject to the provisions of these Bylaws, authority, and responsibility to see that the policies and directives are appropriately followed."

That said, I will authorize our secretary to contact each of you by email to confirm your residency within a 50-mile radius of the Villages. A simple YES or NO is requested in response. If your answer is NO, have no concerns about being removed from our membership list. You have served our country well and are always considered a brother or sister of the Band of Brothers. The issue of residency restrictions will be brought to vote when we recommend revisions to the bylaws. You just will not be able to vote on that outcome. If you feel strongly about opening the radius of votes, please discuss this with your fellow brothers and sisters and let us know how you feel. Keep in mind that many of our members are not permanent residents of Florida and some who are Florida residents live outside the 50-mile radius of The Villages.





Please pay attention to future newsletters that will address proposed changes to the By-Laws, which include, Quorum requirements, potential to extend the Treasurer position to honorary members in good standing – which has already been done for the position of Secretary. This will expand our talent base to include members who have not served in the miliary, but who have the qualifications and understanding of the Band of Brothers methods of operation. To give the Color Guard a budgeted subsidy for the expenses of outfitting a member and paying for expenses such as gas and dry cleaning of uniforms; and increasing the spend limit for expenditures without membership approval from \$250 to \$350 and allowing for higher amounts to be paid for the purchase merchandise for the BX to sell at our stores. Also, to be considered is the staggering of officer's term expirations to enhance continuity of leadership. An aid and attendance allowance is paid to a veteran on claim with compensation of at least 30% or more due to the need of a spouse needing aid and assistance. A form of aid and attendance or housebound income is also available with Service-Connected Compensation (SMC).
