Referencing our Scholarship Program, on 7/11/22 we distributed to all, as a separate email, a correction to the application process. On July 20, we sent out a request for a Membership Vote for \$1700 for a disabled veteran in need of a Lift Chair Mobility Scooter. The vote is closed and the results are 172 yes, 2 no, and 2 abstentions. Additionally, there were four yes votes after the closing deadline which were not included in the count.

Now, here's something for you to think about. At the end of the calendar year 2022, your Officers' terms will end, and just so you know, the current Officers do not plan on running for office again. Nominations of Officers will be held at the October General Membership Meeting, and a separate email will be distributed in early September requesting your nominations for incoming Officers. I would encourage you to speak with the Officer who currently holds the position you may be interested in filling.
